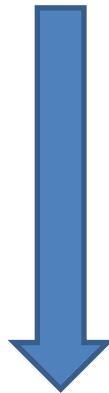


PreK Admission Information
2019-2020 School Year

PreK is not part of the lottery!

When applying for PreK, you will receive a City Schools' application in the spring prior to enrollment. Selection for PreK will be offered first to in-zone, income eligible students, then to siblings of current students and finally to in-zone students. If seats are still available, students will be selected from the out-of- zone list. Forty-six students are selected for PreK per school year, 23 for each homeroom. Your child must turn 4 years old by September 1st of the year of enrollment. In-zone, income eligible students will be registered beginning in early June. On the first workday in August, all remaining students will be considered.
