# Election Day is Tuesday, November 3!

## When and How Can I Vote?

- **In Person at a Voting Center:** October 26 - November 3  
*Early voting: October 26 - November 2, Regular: November 3*
- **By Mail:** As soon as you receive your ballot - November 3
- **By Ballot Drop Box:** End of September - November 3



# Mail-in Voting: Requesting your Ballot

**YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A BALLOT AUTOMATICALLY IN THE MAIL**  
**You must request a mail-in (absentee) ballot by October 20.**

# Mail-in Voting: Who is eligible?

- Everyone! Any registered voter may vote by mail-in ballot.
- You don't need a reason to vote by mail-in ballot. It's another way to vote if you don't want to or can't go to an early voting center or your polling place.

# Mail-in Voting: Submitting your Ballot

## Mail your ballot

- Seal your ballot
- Sign your ballot envelope
- Mail your ballot
  - Mail it early to guarantee timeline delivery!
- Ballots must be postmarked by Nov 3

## Drop your ballot in a drop box

- For your ballot to be counted, you must put it in a drop box by 8 pm on November 3
- Drop box locations are available at <https://boe.baltimorecity.gov/>

# Voting In-Person



**Baltimore City residents can vote at any vote center in the City**

- Early voting starts on **Monday, October 26** and goes through **Monday, November 2**
- Election day is **Tuesday, November 3**
- Each voting center will be open from 7am - 8pm each day  
Anyone in line at 8 pm will be allowed to vote.

# Important dates

**October 14:** Voter registration deadline

**October 20:** Mail-in ballot request must be received by the Board of Elections

**October 26 - November 2:** Early Voting

**November 3:** Election Day & postmark deadline for mail-in ballots.

Make sure that you are registered to vote & that your address is up-to-date
- If you want to vote by mail, **complete your request form** and mail it back as soon as you receive it. The deadline is Oct 20.
- Once you receive your ballot, vote by November 3!
