Hi, this is Principal Hornbeck with your weekly HHA Herald. A reminder that school is closed this coming Monday for President's Day so we have a long weekend coming up. Also, please join me tomorrow, Thursday night from 4-5 pm for this week's Chat with Matt about the details related to reopening HHA for in-person instruction, which is very exciting. Our kindergarten through 2nd grade students will be able to return to in-person instruction starting March 15th and our 3rd through 5th grade students will be able to return to in-person instruction starting April 12th. The district is expected to make an announcement sometime in March about when PreK and middle school students will be able to return. We anticipate an HHA parent survey will be available on our website and distributed by HHA teachers sometime next week. This survey will ask whether you will send your child to in-person instruction. We will ask everyone with students in Kindergarten through 5th grade to respond. Students will be in-person for part of the day and work remotely for part of the day or families may choose to stay fully remote for the remainder of the school year. Please know that it will be much easier for you to opt-in and then decide later to opt-out for whatever reason. If you opt-out at this time you may not be asked again to opt-in.
